**Réka Fekete***Transition*

25.04.15 – 13.06.15

Travelling and relocating, and the associated emotional and practical changes: Réka Fekete experiences these intensely.

Leaving things behind and packing, meeting and discovering. Routes, places, buildings and building sites. How do all these relate to each other and to her?

Her head is a machine in which outside impressions and the way in which she experiences processes of transition are connected with each other to generate new insights and possibilities.

This transition is also evident in her approach to creating jewellery and objects, with maps and routes, constructing and reconstructing. Using individual forms, like letters that have yet to become words. For her jewellery Réka folds and stacks materials such as steel and textile. In her zinc and paper collages she plays with scale, capturing the city as a machine in bird's eye views.

At the *Schmuck* exhibition in Munich **Paul Derrez** was presented with a **Herbert Hofmann Award** for his DOT brooches.

'Optimism, cheerfulness and happiness are qualities which we need most urgently in our times. In Paul Derrez's brooches the jury of the Herbert Hofmann Award sees these qualities combined. The coloured plastic elements are joined in a way that gives them freshness and authenticity. Traditional values of creating jewellery are to be recognized in the careful production and the considered allocation of the colours bestowing on the material an additional relevance and expressiveness'.
