



On **Saturday October 15** Ra Gallery will celebrate its **40 years anniversary!** From 14:30 everyone is welcome in Restaurant Mappa, Nes 59, where at **15:00** Paul Derrez will present the **book: *Ra Gallery 40 years Cherished*** to Carin Reinders, director of the CODA-MUSEUM, Apeldoorn. The Rozettes will enhance the festive mood. At **16:00** in Ra Gallery will open the **exhibition: *Ra Now***, which will show recent work by the artists currently represented by Ra, until December 10.

In the first part of ***Ra Gallery 40 years Cherished***, Paul Derrez gives a personal account of the history of 'his' Ra Gallery. He tells about the philosophy behind the gallery, and about its context, organisation and daily practice. The second part of the book gives a complete overview of the exhibitions and activities organised by Ra in the past forty years. The history of Ra is complemented with anecdotes by Ra-customers and jewellery collectors about cherished pieces of jewellery/art they acquired through the gallery.

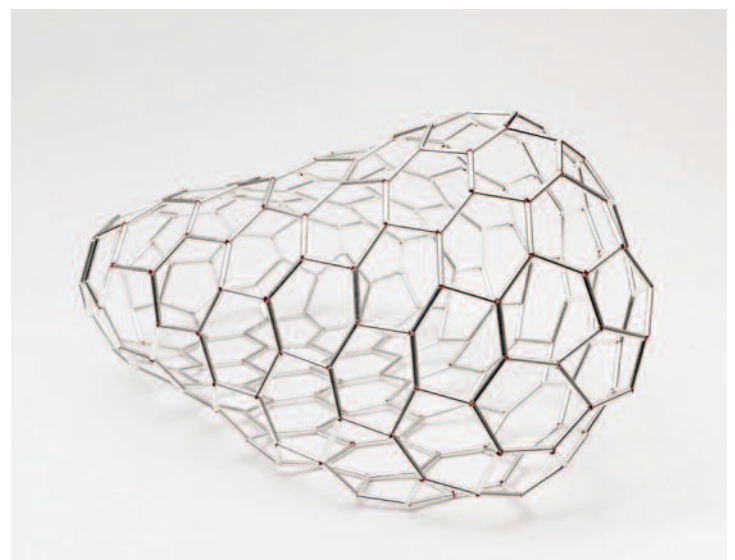
